






Improved Facilities





How will this impact my taxes?

- ➤ House assessed \$50,000......using the \$30,000 STAR program.....
 - 76 cents per month, or \$9.72 per year, or \$180.00 over the life of the bond, less than the cost of a 2 liter bottle of soda!





How will this impact my taxes....Seniors

- ➤ House assessed \$70,000.....using the \$50,000 STAR ENHANCED program.....
 - 76 cents per month, or \$9.72 per year, or \$180.00 over the life of the bond, less than the cost of a 2 liter bottle of soda!
